


# Tiny TV Classics Instruction Manual



#### your new tiny tv!

Thank you for purchasing your brand new Tiny TV Classics set! Please use this guide to help you set up your TV and familiarize yourself with the controls on the TV unit and on the controller.

#### ty unit and controller



## setting up

No cables necessary! After pulling out the Try-Me tab in the back of the unit, simply press the Power button on the side of the unit to turn the unit on.

#### tiny tv surfing

Press CHANNEL UP or CHANNEL DOWN to flip through the channels, either on the TV unit or with the remote control. Press the VOLUME UP and VOLUME DOWN buttons to adjust the volume, either on the TV unit or with the remote control.



The TV unit will cycle through channels and loop back to the first channel. After you get to the last channel, the NO SIGNAL screen will appear.



## sleep mode

After a few minutes, the unit will go into sleep mode to conserve battery power. When in sleep mode, the TV unit can only be woken up either by pressing the POWER button on either the TV unit or the remote control within the first TWO minutes of sleep mode. After that, only the POWER button on the TV unit will work to wake up the TV.

<sup>\*</sup>Please note that you cannot use the control unless the main unit has been powered on first.

#### battery replacement

To replace your batteries, you will need to access the battery door on your unit. This will be located either on the back or on the bottom depending on your TV unit. Using a Phillips/crosshead screwdriver (not included), loosen the screws on the battery door cover (screws stay attached to the cover.) Remove the cover

- (A) TV Unit: Insert 3 x 1.5V "AAA" or LR3 size batteries. Alkaline batteries recommended. Replace battery cover and tighten screws.
- (B) Remote Control: Insert 2 x 1.5V "AG13" or LR44 size batteries. Replace battery door cover and tighten screws.









#### battery information + fcc statement

- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be charged.
- · Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from
- the toy before being charged. . The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed
- · Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.
- · Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the toy.
